Food Service

There will be an **on-site concession on Saturday**. There are many fast-food choices and restaurants in Olds. There will be no formal banquet or exhibitor's dinner arranged.

Exhibitor Sales Area

The show hall will include a buy/sell section. Only exhibitors with birds entered in the show will be permitted to sell in this area. Birds for sale must not be overcrowded, must be in healthy condition and properly cared for while at the show hall. The show committee reserves the right to remove any birds with signs of illness or improper care.

Sales cages must be reserved and paid in advance, preferably with your show entries. Spaces are limited and will be sold on a first come-first served basis.

Large Fowl cages will be available at a cost of \$5.00 per hole.

For larger birds such as geese and turkeys, the seller must supply their own cage. The same fee of \$5.00 per cage will be charged.

General Show Rules

This is a one-day show, with judging and awards to be finished by late afternoon, Saturday.

- 1. **Entering.** All entries must be **RECEIVED on or before Jan 30, 2023**. Late entries will not be accepted. Poultry and Egg show entries can be submitted online through the APBA website or by printing and sending the form via email, text message or fax as per instructions on form.
 - A Pigeon entry form can also be found on the APBA website.
- 2. Payment. Entry fees are \$4.00 per Bird or Egg Show Entry. A Trio is \$10.00. An additional Exhibitor Fee of \$10.00 is charged for each adult exhibitor. This is a one-time added fee for adults only. Junior Exhibitors (under 18) are exempt from the Exhibitor Fee.

All entry fees must be paid in full by entry closing date. Payments will be accepted through the website via Paypal or by e-transfer to the APBA email address: abpoultrybreeders@gmail.com

Refunds: Refunds will ONLY be issued if the event is cancelled. Exhibitors who pull their entries, or do not show up will not be reimbursed. See the website, payments page: payments.html

- 3. Photographs and/or video may be taken at this event. The images resulting from the photography/video filming may be appear on APBA's social media pages, website or be used for educational purposes to help achieve the club's goals. If you do not wish for yourself or your children to be photographed, be sure to inform an officer of the show and avoid areas where and when filming is taking place.
- **4. Entries.** All poultry entries must include Breed, Variety and Sex. "Show Class" numbers are not required. Follow the example on the APBA entry form.
 - Junior and Open Show Egg Entries are to be entered as a group of three. The group of 3 eggs constitutes one entry. (See Egg Show Class section)
 - Painted/decorated eggs are to be entered individually one egg per entry.
 - Indicate Open or Junior division for all Egg Show categories.
 *Junior Exhibitors: Please include your age for painted or decorated eggs
- 5. **Showmanship**. There will be a Junior Showmanship competition. There is no fee or prior registration needed to take part. Please use the sign up sheet at the show registration desk upon arrival at the show if you have a child that is interested in participating. Contestants will be instructed on the time and place to meet.
- **6. Consent.** In making an entry, the exhibitor agrees to be governed by the rules and regulations stated.
- 7. **Bird Health/Vaccination** As a precaution, exhibitors are strongly urged to use a regular vaccination schedule to protect against I.L.T. Birds should be vaccinated at least 30 days prior to the show.
 - **a. Outbreak**. APBA reserves the right to cancel the show in the event of a poultry disease outbreak such as Avian Influenza. In this situation, all registered exhibitors will be notified via email and any paid entry fees will be refunded.
 - **b. Refusal.** All entries must be clean and healthy. The committee reserves the right to reject birds suffering from illness or shown in an unfit condition, and can order removal of those entries at any time.
- **8.** Ownership: All entries must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor at least 30 days prior to the date of the show.
- **9. Interference.** No one except the show committee officials are allowed to handle exhibits without the permission of the owner. Any exhibitor caught tampering with, altering, or injuring exhibits of any competitor will be disqualified from the competition.
- **10. Judge's authority.** The judge's decisions are to be respected. The judge shall have the authority to withhold placings at his/her discretion as merited by the exhibit.

- 11. Bands. Leg bands are not required for poultry.
- **12. Substitutions**. You may make substitutions within the class, provided the Section and Class remains the same as the original entry.
- 13. Judging Guidelines: The latest revised American Standard of Perfection and American Bantam Standard shall be the guide in all poultry entries judged. Specimens must be exhibited in their natural condition, except: Old English Games, Modern Games and American Games cocks large fowl and bantam must be dubbed. Canada Geese, Mallard Ducks, Wood Duck and Mandarin Ducks can be pinioned.

Eggs: The entry of three eggs will be evaluated according to:

- Shell colour and correctness for breed
- Size, shape, uniformity, shell texture (including absence of cracks) Artificial polishing or shiny/glossy coatings will result in disqualification. More information on Egg Competitions is available here: APA Egg Competition
- **14. Coop-in:** All Poultry, Waterfowl, Turkeys, Guinea Fowl and Eggs (Open and Juniors) **must be caged by 9:30 am** on the morning of the show. Cooping-in may start when set-up is completed on Friday evening until 9:00 pm, and on Saturday morning from 7:30 9:00 am. Judging will begin at 9:30 am.
- **15. Coop-out.** Birds may be removed after ALL judging is completed on Saturday afternoon and awards have been announced. Only in exceptional circumstances, and only at the discretion of the committee, may an exhibitor be granted permission to take their birds out early. All exhibits are to be removed from the show area by 10:00 am Sunday. Tear-down help is greatly appreciated!
